

**CITY OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 3 , SERIES 2015**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING JULY 1, 2015 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2016 AS THE FISCAL
YEAR 2016, LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR AND
PROVIDING FOR THE TIME OF PAYMENT AND
EXPENDITURE OF THE PROCEEDS OF SAID LEVIES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY:


1. The fiscal year 2016 of the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky shall be from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
2. An ad valorem tax of 27¢ per hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation is hereby levied for fiscal year 2016, on all lands and improvements and on Franchises in the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, held or owned by every person, firm, company, association and corporation in his, hers, theirs, or its own right, or as a fiduciary, guardian or agent, subject to municipal taxation under the laws of the State of Kentucky in and for said fiscal year.
3. An ad valorem tax of 27¢ per hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation is hereby levied on all motor vehicles within the taxing jurisdiction of the City.
4. The proceeds of said taxes shall be used for general operating expenses of the City including, but not limited to, construction, repair and maintenance of City property, police protection, maintenance of city parks, erection and maintenance of signs, planting and maintenance of shrubs and trees, payment of salaries and expenses of officers and employees, payment of taxes under the Social Security program, office expenses, park maintenance and lighting, insurance payments, purchases of equipment for City use, audit expenses and general purchases of the City in the discharge of its municipal functions.
5. The taxes levied herein shall be due and payable as follows:

Bills paid on or after May 1, 2015, but before June 1, 2015:	Face amount of bill less 2 %
Bills paid on or after June 1, 2015, but before July 1, 2015:	Face amount of bill
Bills paid on or after July 1, 2015, but before August 1, 2015:	Face amount of Bill plus 5%
Bills paid after July 31, 2015:	Face amount of Bill plus 10%

Bills paid on or after July 1, 2015 shall also accrue interest at a rate of 1-½% per month.
In the event of any suit, the taxpayer will pay court costs and attorney fees.
6. Nothing contained in this ordinance shall be construed as preventing the City Council from levying by separate ordinance an ad valorem tax on any class or classes of property excluded from the provisions of this ordinance by the terms thereof.


