In addition to the above activity, we had several officers on the day of the city wide yard sale and the Auktoberfest. We, along with Jason Payne, added extra signage to assist with traffic and parking not only for our celebrations, but for the extra traffic that was a possibility with the Louder than Life events. We are happy to report that we had no major traffic issues with any of our festivities.

We did suffer damage to one of our police vehicles that was parked along Audubon Parkway. A window was broken out by someone in a passing vehicle. Video of the incident is of poor quality, and we are looking into better video technology to assist us in the future.

In September, we also had a theft of a catalytic converter from a vehicle that parked in an apartment parking lot. This is the 2nd theft of a catalytic converter from an apartment parking lot. The report of the first theft was taken in June.

Officers made 6 arrests during the month of September. Two of those arrests were for outstanding felony warrants that were discovered during the investigation of unrelated criminal activity. One arrest was for being in possession of a vehicle that was stolen out of Indiana. Three arrests were made for individuals who were found in possession of stolen property and counterfeit identification.
