Here is a brief review of Code Enforcement Activities for March:

Shifts worked: 4-toal 32 hours

Most types of complaints: downed trees/limbs, junk set out on streets, furniture put on streets for pickup not wrapped up in plastic to protect garbage men from possible bed bug exposure, questions concerning ordinances

2 new complaints from residents: Both corrected.

Self-initiated complaints- 9 violations observed. 8 corrected through mediation, working with last one to resolve.

Previous Complaint Update: Able to close out 2 previous open complaints.

Citations issued: One citation issued.
