There were three reported crimes for the month of April in Audubon Park. There were two separate incidents we had suspects rummage through unlocked cars but did not steal anything. These two incidents are separate from reported crimes. Crime is "through the roof" in Louisville and in this area. We work hard to have the best presence we can with minimal resources. "It works," most of the time. Fortunately, the three reported crimes do not involve non-residents coming into Audubon Park blindly and committing them. Two of the crimes were known family members or family friends and the other crime was an online Fraud Case. Here is a brief synopsis of the police forces activity for May:
