MEMORIAL TREE PROGRAM

This program was designed to honor a deceased person or persons by having a tree planted in their memory. The required minimum donation would be \$500. The Audubon Park Garden Club and Forest Board would determine the variety, size and location of this Memorial Tree and make arrangements to have it planted. A sign will be placed with the information provided by the donor at the time of the request. (See attached form.)

If at any time, the sign or tree is damaged or in need of replacement the donor may request the sign or the tree be replaced. If still under nursery warranty there will be no cost to the donor to replace the tree. If no longer under warranty, the replacement cost will be assumed by the donor.

Upon approval of the request by the Forest Board and Audubon Park Garden Club tree advisors, the tree variety and its donor's name (including contact information) and the name of the person(s) being remembered will be recorded in the official map of the city's parks maintained in the City of Audubon Park Office. The Forest Board and Audubon Park Garden Club will act on these requests, deciding the tree variety, size and location within 60 days of the receipt of this request. They are to write on the request form that the request was accepted or rejected. If accepted they are to note on the request form the variety, size and location of the tree to be planted and may reserve a tree from a nursery. (The tree will be planted at the proper time of spring or fall). They will return a copy of the request form with the notations to the City Clerk so she may record the information on the official map and contact the nursey to authorize purchase of tree or communicate with Forest Board and Garden Club to finalize the purchase. If the request is rejected, the donation will be promptly returned.

MEMORIAL BENCHES

In 2006, when this program was created by the Audubon Park City Council in cooperation with the Audubon Park Garden Club, the goal was to have six steel park benches donated. This program has been extremely well received and appreciated by the many residents who frequent the parks. As of July 2019, there have been 15 benches placed in the parks. The benches remain the same style as originally selected. Due to increased manufacturing cost and delivery charges the required donation is now \$2500. A bronze plaque is affixed to the back of the bench by the manufacture with the name of the person(s) being remembered. (See attached template.) A request for the bench should follow the same process as a request for a tree, but the donor may request a specific park: Robin, Wren, Oriole, Cross Bill or Curlew. The Forest Board and Garden Club representatives will make the final decision based on projected tree growth and maintenance in the area requested. Should a specific park location not be available, you will be contacted and offered another location. The City of Audubon Park and the Audubon Park Garden Club cannot assume financial responsibility for replacement of damaged benches. However, to date none have been damaged or stolen. They are securely installed with concrete mounting.

Process time to accept or decline your request may take up to 90 days. The actual placement of the bench is determined by many factors-manufacturing and shipping schedules and suitable weather conditions for site preparation and installation. This may take 6-8 months. 
BRONZE PLAQUES


