Significant Activity in Audubon Park

There were two theft related reports taken in the month of June. The first was taken on June 5. Someone entered an unlocked garage and removed a box of tools. The toolbox was later recovered under a bush near the victim's residence. On June 20th, there was a report for the theft of a firearm and credit cards from an unlocked vehicle. The firearm has been entered into NCIC, but is still an outstanding stolen. The credit cards were utilized at two nearby gas stations. Detective Murdoch has identified a suspect vehicle and hopes to have the suspect identified soon.

I know you have heard this information in the past, but it bears repeating. We continue to ask residents and council members to use our dispatch center when reporting suspicious or criminal activity. This is not meant to discourage anyone from calling. It is simply a means to lessen any delay in getting the information to an on duty officer and a means to document that there was a call for service in our community. This does four things. It speeds up our response time, increases officer safety, helps keep an accurate record of events and helps protect the officers, the department and ultimately, the city from false claims of harassment and profiling. A call for service should never come through an officer's, a council member's, or the mayor's personal cellphone. Please, help me spread that message and reduce liability for the City.
