POLICE DEPARTMENT SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES REPORT

March 2021

Audubon Park has took eight reports during March. This is probably a record. Here is a brief synopsis of the police forces activity for March:

- Reported Crime: Three reports of residents being victims of Unemployment Insurance Fraud. Three collisions- Hess Lane (No injuries), Preston Highway (Hit and Run, Arrest made), Eagle Pass/Crossbill (no residents were involved in these collisions, person that was not at fault left the scene of the accident). Stolen vehicle by house guest on Audubon Parkway. We located vehicle and person driving it and made an arrest. Theft from vehicle on Robin Road. Wallet was in plain view and vehicle was unlocked.
- Traffic Enforcement: Thirty-seven vehicles were stopped. Twenty-two verbal warnings and Fifteen tickets written. Four of these tickets were in Audubon Park. Eleven tickets at Audubon Parkway/Preston Highway during Highway Safety Grant.
- Parking Citations: Eight Parking Tickets were written for "Parking in Grass" and "Overnight Parking." Two warnings were given for overnight parking.
- Suspicious Persons: We stopped twelve non-residents of Audubon Park we believe were in the neighborhood with the intent to commit a crime. One of the subjects were arrested for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
