Council Meeting Minutes

October 17, 2022

The regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of Audubon Park was held on Monday, October 17, 2022, at 3340 Robin Road. The following were present Mayor Tony Williams, City Clerk Janette Mercer, Chief Teddy Laun, and Councilmembers Daniel Stephen, Michael Hartman, Andrew Klump, Austin Schwenker.

Call to Order

The mayor called the meeting to order at 6:01 PM.

Roll Call

Opening Public Comments

Pete Becker, 3105 Chickadee - Mr. Becker suggested that cameras be placed at the 5-way to help with cars stopping at the sign. The Chief stated it would be very expensive.

Laura Miller, 3141 Preston Highway (Vic's Classic Bikes) – Ms. Miller wanted to ask about parking on Preston, to be limited to 2 hours during big events. She is asking because the businesses on Preston have limited parking as is and becomes a problem during big events.

Financial Report

The mayor noted the written reports and opened the floor for a motion to approval the reports. Andrew Klump made a motion to approve. Michael Hartman seconded. The motion passed with 4 in favor (Andrew Klump, Michael Hartman, Daniel Stephen and Austin Schwenker in favor) (Madeline Bozeman and Elyse Shackleton absent).

Unfinished Business

Mayor Williams started the conversation about the 5-way. Andrew Klump and Daniel Stephen presented a couple of documents showing the plans for the 5-way and an estimated cost between \$13K to \$15K. The council agreed to move ahead with the plan. Mayor presented a picture of an entrance sign for the approval for the entrance at Eagle Pass and Audubon Parkway. The estimated cost should be between \$2.5K to \$3.5K. There were conversations about the remaining sidewalks repairs.

The donation to the Fire Department was discussed.

New Business

Mayor Williams presented the minutes from September to be approved. Andrew Klump made a motion to approve the minutes. Michael Hartman seconded, and the motion passed with 4 in favor (Andrew Klump, Austin Schwenker, Michael Hartman and Daniel Stephen in favor) (Madeline Bozeman and Elyse Shackleton absent).

Mayor's report

The mayor made comments about the festivals. He stated Halloween is still set for Monday. Mayor wants to hold an auction to sell the street signs and some additional items from the garage. The council has decided to not hold a meeting in December as there is no business to discuss. There was a suggestion to move the November meeting to an earlier date. A Holiday celebration was suggested.

Closing Public Comment

Mr. Ebert Haegele candidate for Circuit Court Judge came and introduced himself and asked for everyone's vote.

Laura Miller, 3141 Preston Highway (Vic's Classic Bike) - Ms. Miller wanted to know who will be the next mayor, because would like to start the bike ride back up that they did before Covid hit.

Andrew Klump made a motion to adjourn. Austin Schwenker seconded, and the motion passed with 4 in favor (Andrew Klump, Austin Schwenker, Michael Hartman and Daniel Stephen in favor) (Madeline Bozeman and Elyse Shackleton absent).
