We also took a report on a vehicle that was stolen from a driveway on Crossbill. The vehicle was impounded by Louisville Metro Police Department in the area of Preston and Brandeis. All valuables, including a laptop, were still present in the vehicle and there was no damage to vehicle. The vehicle was recovered before it was reported stolen.

As we enjoy the Holiday season, we encourage residents to check their vehicle doors and the entries to their residences and garages as a part of their nightly routine.
