

POLICE DEPARTMENT SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES REPORT

December 2019

There was increased criminal activity in Audubon Park during December. Police are aware of 6 different nights suspects went through unlocked cars. Most nights, nothing reported stolen. However, due to pictures and videos sent to me from “Ring Cameras,” we are closing in on solving these crimes. Police have excellent videos and photographs of two suspects with the stolen property at a gas station on Taylor Blvd. We posted pictures of the suspects on the news, social media, and LMPD. One of the suspects is a juvenile. I have reached out to JCPS Security to help identify the Juvenile that committed the crime. LMPD 6th Division worked closely with APPD on the recent crime spree. They are lending their “Traffic Speed Sign Machine” to our city for two weeks. We have also parked our extra police car in different parts of the neighborhood.

Traffic Violations: Police conducted four traffic stops. Four warnings given.

Parking Citations: Eight Parking Tickets written for “overnight parking” and three for “Parking Wrong Way on Street.” Three courtesy notices written for parking violations.

Suspicious Persons: We stopped seven non-residents of Audubon Park we believe we're in the neighborhood with the intent to commit a crime.
