A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR ADMINISTRATION OF KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY PROJECTS

A RESOLUTION of the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, authorizing the Mayor to make application for and, upon arrival, to enter into an agreement with the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security (KOHS), to execute any documents which are deemed necessary by KOHS to facilitate and administer the project and to act as the authorized correspondent for this project.

WHEREAS, the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, Jefferson County, Kentucky, desires to make an application for Law Enforcement Protection Program funds for a project to be administered by Kentucky Office of Homeland Security.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that an application for and approval of Kentucky Office of Homeland Security funds impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the City/County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved this 16th day of March 2020, by the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, Jefferson County Kentucky.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and furnish all required documentation, including a memorandum of agreement, as may be required by KOHS for the furtherance of the above-referenced project and to act as the authorized correspondent for said project.

AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: Approval of Agreements. The Application for and administration of Kentucky Office of Homeland Security Projects is approved.


