ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AUDUBON PARK TO USE THE STANDARD ALLOWANCE FOR THE CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS (SLFRF) PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS**, Kentucky cities will receive a combined \$931 million over a two-year period through the State and Local Fiscal Relief Recovery Fund, which is part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) signed by President Biden in March 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, The final rule offers a standard allowance for revenue loss of up to \$10 million, allowing recipients to select a standard amount of revenue loss. The City of Audubon Park may use up to the award amount for government services, with streamlined reporting requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved this 31st day of January, 2022 , by the City of Audubon Park that:

The City of Audubon is electing to use the standard allowance of up to \$10 million in aggregate, not to exceed our award amount during the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program.
