

CITY OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NUMBER 006 SERIES 2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY
OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY CONCERNING FENCES.

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the City to maintain public safety within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that an amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the City will further such interest;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AUDUBON PARK:

(1) Section 15-7.01(f) of Chapter 7 of Title XV of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following subsection (iii) to read as follows:

- (iii) The owner of any lot on the North Side of Audubon Parkway and the West Side of Oriole Drive whose rear lot line abuts the city limits of Louisville Metro may erect and maintain a fence of up to eighty-four (84) inches in height along such rear lot line.

This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, signing and publication as required by law.

This Ordinance was passed and adopted at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, held on the 17th day of August, 2009, having first been read at a meeting held on the 27th day of July, 2009.
