

**CITY OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 0001, SERIES 2004**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SALARY FOR ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS**

**WHEREAS**, KRS 83A.070 authorizes the legislative body of a city to establish the compensation of elected city officers by ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the time required for elected city officers to fulfill their obligations has increased due to the growing complexity of statutory, regulatory and other rules; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important to the continued efficient operation of city government and the well-being of its citizens that the City of Audubon Park continue to attract and retain qualified individuals to fill positions as elected city officers;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY:**

- (1) Chapter 4 of Title III of the Code of Ordinances of the City is hereby amended to add new Section 3-4.08 to read as follows:


**Sec. 3-4.08 Compensation**

- (a) The Mayor shall be paid a salary of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month and each member of the City Council shall be paid a salary of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month.
- (b) Salaries shall be paid on the first day of each month and shall be subject to all applicable taxes. Such taxes shall be reported on Federal Form W-2, or other applicable form, in the same manner as City employees.
- (2) Any portion of the Code of Ordinances of the City in conflict with paragraph (1), above, is hereby repealed.
- (3) This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, signing and publication as required by law, and shall apply to City officers taking office on and after January 1, 2005.

This Ordinance was passed and adopted at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Audubon Park, Kentucky, held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2004, having first been read at a meeting held on the 15th day of March, 2004.
